

PENN A-4

Creeping Bentgrass

Penn A-4 is dark green with fine leaf texture, exceptional heat and cold tolerance. Penn A-4 will provide a good playing surface for tees and fairways. Penn A-4 provides a smooth grainless putting surface.

Characteristics:

- Excellent disease resistance.
- Aggressive growth habit (crowds out other weed grasses)
- Exceptional heat & cold tolerance
- Dark green color
- High seedling vigor

Recommended Use:

Golf courses Tees and Greens

Establishment and Maintenance:

Sow seed two directions at 90° angles. Seed will germinate best when soil temperature is above 65° F (18° C). Irrigate frequently and lightly until seedlings are established. Avoid excess watering or puddling. First cutting for fairways and tees should be ½ inch (12 mm) when seedlings reach ¾ inch (19 mm) in height.

Seeding Rates:

- New construction (bare ground) 1-1½ lb/1,000 sq ft (½ - ¾ kg/100 sq m)
- Overseeding (existing greens) ½-1 lb/1,000 sq ft (¼- ½ kg/100 sq m)
